### History

Founded in 1955 in the Detroit area as "Michigan Community Blood Centers". Today, as Michigan Blood, the exclusive blood provider for many hospitals across Michigan's Lower Peninsula.

### Services

**Blood Collection:** Allogeneic donations accepted at all sites; autologous and directed donation, apheresis donation, and therapeutic apheresis at selected sites.

**Mobile Blood Drives** with individual sponsors (businesses, schools, churches, other organizations), plus community-wide blood drives in many areas.

**Laboratory Services:** Central laboratory in Grand Rapids provides blood typing, testing, component separation, as well as red cell reference lab plus DNA, HLA, cord blood, and stem cell labs.

**Blood Storage and Distribution** for local hospitals statewide, provided from distribution centers in Grand Rapids, St. Joseph, Traverse City, and Saginaw.

**Professional Development:** Teleconferences and seminars for medical and technical staff and physicians. Locations vary (details at [www.miblood.org](http://www.miblood.org)).

**Marrow/Stem Cell Donor Registry** for Be The Match Registry (international database of the National Marrow Donor Program), plus supportive services for marrow donors, recipients, and families.

**Stem Cell/Cord Blood Bank:** Located in Grand Rapids. Michigan's first Cord Blood Bank. One of only a few public (no charge to donate) such facilities in the U.S.

**Education Program:** Demonstrations, age-appropriate presentations, and tours, free of charge, for school and community groups on request.

**Medical/Clinical Consultations:** Medical Director and Associate Medical Director, plus Laboratory and Donor Services staff, are available to consult with donors, hospital personnel, and physicians.
